
Licensing of I-CARE

Cyberspace Assisted Responsive Education (CARE) is a computer-mediated system for brings learners and teachers in a virtual environment. The implementation of CARE in Internet is the I-CARE version, which provides tools and techniques of Internet communication, group interaction and interactive support for conducting distance-less and group teaching and learning.

The I-CARE software is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties. It is not freeware or shareware and may not be distributed or sold without the expressed, written consent of Dr. Ifay Chang, the creator of I-CARE. Dr. Chang has all the legal rights to I-CARE for bringing I-CARE into any commercial application. Polytechnic University where Dr. Chang was associated with is the only institution granted a license to use I-CARE free of charge.

Grant of License: A grant of license may be issued to an applicant under the following terms:

- 1. The applicant is a legitimate business. The applicant has submitted a credit application, a trade reference and a business plan outlining how I-CARE will be used.
- 2. The applicant has agreed or proposed to pay a license fee for I-CARE.

The usage of the I-CARE system must be clearly described in the business plan in terms of how many computers or servers I-CARE will be installed on. This will facilitate the determination of an appropriate license fee. Once granted a license, the applicant organization may use I-CARE to offer any course or training electronically to anyone deemed appropriate, through whatever telecommunication medium, including Internet and/or Intranet.

The license of I-CARE may be granted on a per year basis or on a longer term depending on the license fee agreed upon. Upon the expiration of the license, no copies of the I-CARE software will be retained on any medium in the possession of the applicant organization to which it has been licensed.

Restrictions and Limitations: You may not reverse engineer, decompose or disassemble I-CARE software. However, you may freely alter and add other or additional materials (in addition to the information materials contained in the I-CARE package) in order to adapt the content to whatever needs your organization may have. You may make modifications to the I-CARE software only after obtaining expressed, written permission from Dr. Chang.

I-CARE software provides demo system and sample courses. I-CARE is offered, "as is". With additional fee, a software maintenance contract may be obtained from TLC Information Services or its licensed partners.
